Timex Atelier GMT 24 M1a: Setting the Time


Setting the Time (Crown Position 3)

Unscrew the crown and pull the crown out to Position 3 to set the hour and minute hands. Once the time is set, push the crown back and screw it down to lock it securely.

Setting the GMT Hand (Crown Position 2)

Unscrew the crown and pull it out to Position 2. Turn the crown clockwise to set the GMT (24-hour) hand.

After adjustments, push the crown in and screw it back tightly.



Note: The watch is self-winding by the movements of the wrist. To wind the watch by hand:


Unscrew the crown to reach Position 1.

With the crown in Position 1, manually wind the watch by turning the crown clockwise about 20 times. This action will charge the mainspring. After winding, screw it down to lock it securely.

The watch offers a power reserve of approximately 40 hours. During wear, the automatic rotor continues to wind the mainspring using the natural movement of your wrist.

Resize the Bracelet with Self-Adjustable Links

- 1 Select adjustable links with the symbol \hookrightarrow
- 2 Pull out and rotate the adjustable links with the symbol ← to open
- 3 Remove the desired number of adjustable links
- 4 Pull out and rotate again to close and secure the bracelet. \hookrightarrow
